SPRED - Special Second Collection On 24th February 2019: This was swapped with the collection for Catholic Education on 25th November 2018. Our Paisley Diocese SPRED offers people with learning disabilities a personal friend who takes time to share life and faith, spiritual nurture in a small community of faith, and a sense of belonging to a parish community. Twenty-one SPRED groups meet in our church halls and special needs schools, allowing two hundred parishioners to come together in faith and friendship to share and experience God's love. Paisley SPRED supports three employees. "In SPRED I feel that I belong and everyone is my friend". In 2017 this collection, with our Advent SPRED boxes and Friends Campaign, raised £39,556 which represents 54% of our expenditure of £73,275, resulting in a shortfall of £34,352 which was made up from Diocesan reserves.
